**Amended  
Resolution #08-08-19/108-02**

**Designating the Polling Places  
for the 2019 Local Election**

**WHEREAS**, the original Resolution #9/21/17\106-08 was approved on September 21, 2017, and the Amended Resolution #6-13-19/107-80 was approved on June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019, ***Designating the Polling Places for the 2018-2019 Elections***. This amendment to the amended resolution is to correct certain precinct numbers that will not go into effect until 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the New Mexico Statutes Annotated 1978, Section 1-3-2, requires that in June or July of the odd-numbered year, the Board of County Commissioners shall by resolution designate polling places; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners find that each polling place designated in this resolution complies with the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-7, titled Polling Places; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners find that those precincts that are consolidated to create Voting Convenience Centers meet the requirements of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-4, will be available to voters of any precinct in the county to cast a vote at the Voting Convenience Center, will make voting more convenient and accessible to voters of the consolidated precinct, will not result in delays for voters in the voting process, and are centrally located within the consolidated precinct; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners find that those precincts not consolidated to create Voting Convenience Centers are designated as Rural Precincts pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-4(B)(7), permitting the voters of those precincts the option of voting in their precinct on election day or in a Voting Convenience Center; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners find that those precincts designated as Mail Ballot Election Precincts meet the qualifications of NMSA 1978, Section 1-6-22.1, have fewer than one hundred (100) voters, and the nearest polling place for an

adjoining precinct is more than twenty (20) miles driving distance from the boundary of the Mail Ballot Election Precinct; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners find that each polling place provides individuals with physical mobility limitations unobstructed access to at least one voting machine.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners designate the polling locations for the 2019 Local Elections as follows:




